

LICENSE REQUEST FOR KEEPING OF POULTRY HENS

No person shall own, harbor or keep in his or her possession more than six (6) hens per half acre lot

The keeping of poultry hens shall be permitted subject to the following conditions.

- (1) No person shall keep any rooster.
- (2) No person may slaughter any hen within the village limits.
- (3) Hens shall be provided with a covered enclosure and kept in a covered or fenced enclosure all the time.
- (4) No permanent enclosure may be closer than twenty-five (25) feet to any residential structure on adjacent lots and no closer than ten (10) feet to any lot line.
- (5) The owner shall obtain a license from the village by March 31st of the current year or upon acquiring chickens and constructing a coop.
- (6) Construction of Animal Shelters: All coops, yards, pens or other structures wherein any hen is kept shall be constructed to be easily cleaned and kept in good repair. All such structures shall be kept clean and sanitary and shall not cause any objectionable odor. All structures will be secure from predators.
- (7) All structures need to be inspected by a board member or the Police Chief.
- (8) Hens must be confined and are not allowed to run loose.
- (9) In no event shall any person have more than six (6) chickens per half acre at a residence, except upon issuance of a waiver.
